DON'T LET YOUR HOME **BREED RODENTS!** TIPS TO KEEP YOUR HOME AND NEIGHBORHOOD RAT FREE Maintaining your property and properly storing your trash will prevent rats and other pests from living in our neighborhoods. You can be fined \$50 to \$100 for violations. **OUTDOORS** Remove weeds and debris near buildings and in yards where rats can hide Avoid landscaping low to ground vegetation (e.g., juniper, liriope) next to buildings • Store lumber and other items on a rack with a clean, open area underneath HOME Inspect walls for cracks where rodents could enter and seal with mortar • Inspect screens on windows and repair/replace as necessary • Add metal weather stripping and trim to doors to prevent gnawing and entering underneath Bag your trash before putting it in the can • Rinse food waste off recyclables before PETS setting out for pickup. Do not bag. • Place trash outside shortly before pickup Pick up, bag, and dispose of • Keep lids closed and do not overfill cans waste in your household trash or • Request repairs or replacements for a public litter can Store pet food and bird seed in gnawed cans by calling 311 secure containers
